

Service Technician (Mechanical) **Job Description**

Summary

Troubleshoot and repair mechanical and minor electrical equipment on drilling rigs. Equipment may include mud pumps, drawworks, blocks, swivels, rotary drives, motion compensators, cranes, top drives, pipe-handling systems and subsea equipment. Ascertain condition of equipment and determine repairs required, and pass on to client all required repairs.

Note: Not all personnel falling under this job description will have the knowledge of all the equipment listed above. Personnel will need to have the willingness to learn new equipment and product lines.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities. Other duties may be assigned.

- Assess equipment as outlined above.
- Understand and apply assessment points included in the test procedure.
- Observe all site specific safety rules as well as WEST safety rules.
- Establish and maintain a good working relationship with client and drilling contractor personnel.
- Compose and publish daily reports, submit to client and WEST home office.
- Provide recommendations of required repairs to client based on assessment of equipment.
